

General Code of Conduct

As a member of Maranoa Equestrian Club Inc.), or a person required to comply with Maranoa Equestrian Club Inc. member protection policy, you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any activity held or sanctioned by the Maranoa Equestrian Club Inc., and in any role you hold within the Maranoa Equestrian Club Inc.:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others
- Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealing with others
- ♣ Be professional in, and accept responsibility for, your actions
- Make a commitment to providing quality service
- ♣ Be aware of, and maintain an uncompromising adhesion to, Maranoa Equestrian Club Inc. standards, rules, regulations and policies
- Operate within the rules of the sport including national and international guidelines which govern Equestrian Sport, the member associations and the affiliated clubs
- ♣ Do not use your involvement with the Maranoa Equestrian Club Inc., its member associations or affiliated clubs to promote your own beliefs, behaviours or practices where these are inconsistent with those of Maranoa Equestrian Club Inc.
- ♣ Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are an example
- Avoid unaccompanied and unobserved activities with persons under 18 years of age, wherever possible
- Refrain from any form of harassment of others
- A Refrain from any behaviours that may bring the Maranoa Equestrian Club Inc., its member associations or affiliated clubs into disrepute
- Provide a safe environment for the conduct of the activity
- Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured
- Be a positive role model
- ♣ Understand the repercussions if you breach, or are aware of any breaches or, this code of behaviour
